### **Post Hire and Pre-Orientation**

- Visits to campus
- Housing Needs
- Human Resources Requirements
- Mentors
- Technology Needs
- Curriculum R&D and Professional Development

## **Orientation**

- Two Day Event (one on each campus)
- Highest priority items make it to the schedule
- Breakfast and lunch provided each day which includes mentors
- Admin Team integral part of presentation

- Email

## **Year One – Cohort Experiences**

- Monitoring via Check-Ins
- Five Events (spread throughout year)
- Two Surveys (fall and spring)

### **Year One – Lower School**

- Welcome email sent once hire is confirmed
- Email communication regarding mentor assignment; mentors are copied on the message
- Guidelines are provided for all mentors
- Check-in Messages sent to all mentors mid-way through the first semester
- Welcome packet (that includes summer reading selection)
   mailed in July
- Lower School New Faculty Handbook
- Email reminders for upcoming induction events
- Morning Meetings "Coffee Talk"
- Classroom observations twice within the year (fall and spring)

### **Year One – Middle School**

- Advisory In-service
- Middle School New Faculty Handbook
- Mentor Meetings (within grade level, but not within department)
- Classroom Visit (15 min) before Parents Night
- Formal observation by Division Head and Director of Studies by Nov. 1
- Monthly Morning Meetings
- Invite mentors/leaders to lead monthly meetings
- Coffee/Lunch Trips with Mentors

## **Year One – Upper School**

- Mentors and Advisories
- Informal and Formal Class Observations
- First Semester Meetings (10 lunch meetings)
- Second Semester Meetings (3 lunch meetings and one off-campus lunch in small groups)

### **Year Two**

- Often become mentors
- Continue to attend socials
- Inspired to start program for new students
